



A Liturgical Feast dedicated to honor God under the title of Father of All Mankind on the first Sunday in August. This authentic photo was painted at Mother Eugenia's request after receiving direct apparitions from God in 1932. Bishop A. Caillot of Grenoble in 1935 set up a board of six experts to conduct a diocesan enquiry which lasted ten years. All six board members approved as valid the message given from the Father of All Mankind to His children in the world. Jesuit brothers, Father Albert and August Valencin-Amons both ranked high experts where on that diocesan enquiry. The Vatican in 1989 mandated an imprimatur seal the doctrine for God the Father of All Mankind Liturgical Feast.
